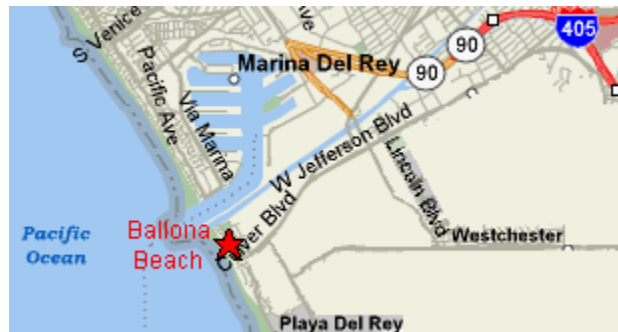




Directions to Ballona Beach Summer Day Camp, LLC



From Culver City & Mar Vista:

To reach camp travel West on the 90 Marina Freeway. Exit Culver Boulevard and make a left. Take Culver Boulevard to Pacific Avenue and make a right. Enter parking lot on right located between 64th Avenue and 65th Avenue on the southside. In this parking lot you will sign-in/sign-out your child(ren).

From El Segundo & Manhattan Beach:

To reach camp travel north on Highland Avenue (turns into Vista Del Mar). Make a left onto Culver Boulevard, and then a right onto Pacific Avenue. Enter parking lot on right located between 64th Avenue and 65th Avenue on the southside. In this parking lot you will sign-in/sign-out your child(ren).

-Or-

To reach camp travel north on the 405 Freeway. Merge onto the 90 Marina Freeway West. Exit Culver Boulevard and make a left. Take Culver Boulevard to Pacific Avenue and make a right. Enter parking lot on right located between 64th Avenue and 65th Avenue on the southside. In this parking lot you will sign-in/sign-out your child(ren).

From Marina Del Rey:

To reach camp travel south on Lincoln Boulevard. Make a right onto Jefferson Boulevard, and then a left onto Culver Boulevard. Thereafter, make a right on Pacific Avenue. Enter parking lot on right located between 64th Avenue and 65th Avenue on the southside. In this parking lot you will sign-in/sign-out your child(ren).

From Westchester:

Take Lincoln Blvd. north. Make a left onto Jefferson Blvd. Make another left onto Culver Blvd. Thereafter, make a right on Pacific Avenue. Enter parking lot on right located between 64th Avenue and 65th Avenue on the southside. In this parking lot you will sign-in/sign-out your child(ren).

Ballona Beach Summer Day Camp, LLC Drop-Off and-Pick Up



Welcome to the beach!

All drop-off and pick-up during the times of 9:00 to 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 to 4:00 p.m. will be conducted in the parking lot on Pacific Avenue. It is on the eastside of the street located between 64th Avenue and 65th Avenue. In this parking lot you will sign-in or sign-out your child(ren) with one of our counselors in light blue shirts.

Our Office

For any late arrivals or early pick-ups we ask that parents park in the public parking spaces just west of the basketball courts in Del Rey Lagoon Park, and then cross the street to the beach. You will find our office just to the west of Toes Beach (dunes), use the pathway labeled "Temporary Beach Access." Calling our office at least one hour ahead is advised for parents who are in a hurry.

Please Remember

- All campers need to bring a pre-packed lunch from home.
- All campers need to bring sun block from home.
- All campers' swimwear needs to be worn to camp.
- For safety reasons anyone picking up campers must know your family pick-up word. This will save time as, persons who do not know the pick-up word will have to wait while parent(s) are contacted.

UCLA Aquatic Center

Any campers (ages 7 and -14) that are scheduled to go off-site for UCLA Youth Programs will do so at the Marina Aquatic Center. The aquatic center is a short walk (10 minutes) from Ballona Beach. While there, our campers (ages 7-14) will get to learn from trained professionals the basics of sea kayaking, and the fundamentals of sailing, and for campers ages 11-14 windsurfing. Life jackets are worn at all times and this all takes place within the harbor, making it the perfect class for beginners. Our 11-14 year olds will also have the opportunity to participate in surfing, again under the instruction of UCLA Youth Programs at their site on Venice Beach (campers will be transported by van). It is not mandatory for campers to take part in these activities, however counselors will be present with a few techniques to encourage those who are just not sure (unless otherwise specified by parent/guardian). Any camper not ready to venture out will remain on dock with a counselor and play games. **Please take notice of the separate Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement that must be completed for participation in kayaking and sailing. Both pages must be completed and returned.**
